



GREATER COLUMBIA BEHAVIORAL HEALTH REGIONAL ADVISORY BOARD MEMBERSHIP RECRUITMENT

The Greater Columbia Behavioral Health (GCBH) Regional Advisory Board is currently seeking representation for the Yakama Nation, Cowlitz Tribe and the Eastern Region (Asotin, Garfield, Columbia, Walla Walla, and Whitman Counties) for a voluntary position.

The GCBH Regional Advisory Board is a statutory citizen's advisory board which advises the GCBH Board of Directors on public funded services available within GCBH. The Regional Advisory Board reviews and provides comments and/or recommendations on plans and policies, and serves on workgroups and committees of GCBH.

Interested citizens need not be involved in the mental health field, although an interest in improving the lives of persons with mental illness is necessary. Racial/ethnic minorities, persons with disabilities and parents of children currently in mental health services are encouraged to apply. The Regional Advisory Board meets the fourth Tuesday of every month from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Prospective candidates should be able to devote a minimum of six hours a month to board activities. Appointments are made for three year renewable terms.
